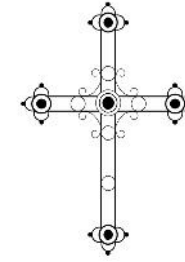

Easter Anthems

Christ our Passover is sacrificed for *us*: therefore *let* us keep the feast.

Not with the old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wick-ed-ness: but with the unleavened bread of sin-cer-i-ty and truth.

Christ being raised from the dead dieth no *more*: death hath no more do-min-ion over him.

For in that he died he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liv-eth unto God.

Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead unto *sin*: but alive unto God through *Je-sus* Christ our Lord.

Christ is risen from the dead: and become the first-fruits of them that slept.

For since by man came *death*: by man has come also the resur-rec-tion of the dead.

For as in Adam all die: even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

Almighty God, who through thine only-begotten Son Jesus Christ hast overcome death, and opened unto us the gate of everlasting life; We humbly beseech thee, that as by thy special grace preventing us thou dost put into our minds good desires, so by thy continual help we may bring the same to good effect: through Jesus Christ our Lord...
