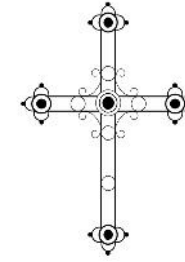

8 My heart is fixed, O God, my heart is *fix*-ed: I will *sing* and give praise.

9 Awake up my glory; awake, lute and harp: I myself will a-wake right early.

10 I will give thanks unto thee, O Lord, among the *peo*-ple: and I will sing unto thee *a-mong* the nations.
