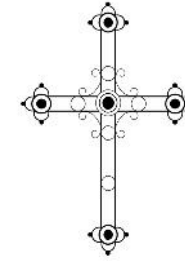

All Saints and All Souls: Wednesday 1st and Tuesday 2nd November.

All Saints Day, November 1st, we rejoice in the fellowship and prayers of all the Saints, known and unknown, of every time and culture. 12.30pm Mass at St Thomas: 6pm High Mass at Pusey House : Preacher: the Bishop of Oxford.
