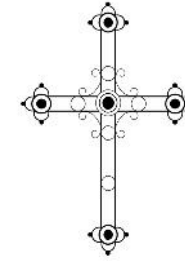

1 Lord thou hast been our *re-fuge*: from one generation *to* another.

2 Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever the earth and the world were made: thou art God from everlasting, and world without end.

3 Thou turnest man to des-*truc*-tion: again thou sayest, Come again, ye children of men.

4 For a thousand years in thy sight are but as yes-*ter*-day: seeing that is past as a watch in the night.
