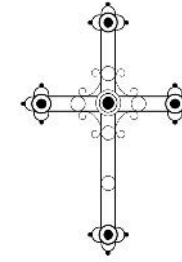

8 I will hearken what the Lord God will *say* concerning me: for he shall speak peace unto his people, and to his saints, that they *turn* not again.

9 For his salvation is nigh *them* that fear him: that glory may *dwell* in our land.

10 Mercy and truth are *met* together: righteousness and peace have *kissed* each other.

11 Truth shall flourish out of the earth: and righteousness hath look-ed down from heaven.

12 Yea, the Lord shall show *lov-ing* kindness: and our land shall *give* her increase.

13 Righteousness shall go before him: and he shall direct his go-ing in the way.
