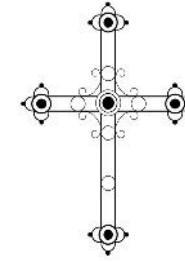

**Psalm 9.16-end**

**Tone 6**

16 The Lord is known to execute *judge-ment*: the ungodly is trapped in the work of his own hands.

**17 The wicked shall be turn-ed in-to hell: and all the people that forget God.**

18 For the poor shall not always be for-got-ten: the patient abiding of the meek shall not per-ish for ever.

**19 Up, Lord, and let not man have the up-per hand: let the heathen be judg-ed in thy sight.**

20 Put them in fear, O Lord: that the heathen may know them-selves to be but men.
