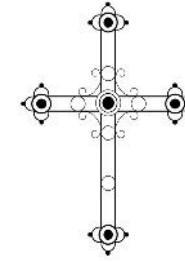

Tone 8.1

1 The Lord is my *shep*-herd: therefore can I lack nothing.

2 He shall feed me in a green *past-ure*: and lead me forth beside the *wa-ters* of comfort.

3 He shall convert my *soul*: and bring me forth in the paths of righteousness, *for* his name's sake.

4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no *e-vil*: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy *staff* comfort me.

5 Thou shalt prepare a table before me against them that *trou-ble* me: thou hast anointed my head with oil, and my *cup* shall be full.

6 But thy loving-kindness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my *life*: and I shall dwell in the house of the *Lord* for ever.
